Kemi Badenoch was elected the Member of Parliament for Saffron Walden in 2017. She was appointed as a Vice-Chairman of the Conservative Party in 2018 and is currently Secretary of State for International Trade and the President of the Board of Trade. Kemi came fourth in the Party Leadership race last year.

Previously roles included Minister for Levelling Up Communities, Minister for Equalities, Exchequer Secretary to the Treasury and Parliamentary

Under-Secretary at the Department for Education.

Before her election to Parliament, she was a Conservative member of the London Assembly, and a Director at the Spectator magazine. Prior to this she was an Associate Director of Coutts & Co. She has a degree in engineering and law from Sussex University and Birkbeck College, respectively. Her interests include the rule of law; engineering and technology; social mobility and integration.
